- (1) Town board members may participate in the annual town meeting their role as qualified electors, including engaging in discussion and information sharing, being recognized to speak, to make motions and seconds (except the meeting chairman), and to vote. This is not a town board meeting. No formal action of the town board will be taken.
- (2) Per the provisions of 60.13 Wis. Stats, the Annual Town Meeting shall be run in accordance with the rules for parliamentary procedure as adopted in the local (Town of Three Lakes) Code. The town chairman serves as annual meeting chairman. The chairman cannot make motions or seconds but may vote on any matters that come before the meeting.
- (3) Per the provisions of 60.13 Wis. Stats, order and decorum is to be maintained and the meeting chairperson has the power to enforce against and remove any person who conducts her/himself in a disorderly manner at an annual town meeting.
